



CPI to Percentage Conversion

(for students admitted for first year before 2018)

Vishwakarma Institute of Technology is an Autonomous Institute affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly known as University of Poona/ University of Pune). The institute has adopted a credit based grading system for the evaluation of academic performance of the student as per the requirement of UGC, New Delhi. Accordingly, it awards cumulative performance index (CPI) and not the marks, percentage and class during every semester.

Formula for conversion of CPI to Percentage = **(CPI x 9)**

The pattern for award of classes of Savitribai Phule Pune University is as under: -

Aggregate 66% or more marks	First Class with Distinction
Aggregate 60% or more marks but less than 66%	First Class
Aggregate 55% or more marks but less than 60%	Higher Second Class
Aggregate 50% or more marks but less than 55%	Second Class
Aggregate 40% or more marks but less than 50%	Pass Class
