FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (SECOND YEAR DIRECT ADMISSION (SEDA)-2021-22)

Q. 1. What is the procedure for getting admission for B. Tech. in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology through Second Year Engineering Direct Admission (SEDA) process?

Ans: The Candidate must be an **Indian National** and should have passed **Post-SSC or Post-HSC Diploma Course** in Engineering/Technology with at least **45 % marks (40 %** marks in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in appropriate branch of Engineering / Technology from an AICTE approved Institution with English as the medium of instruction at Diploma level.

OR

The Candidate must be an Indian National and should have passed **B.Sc. Degree** from a UGC / Association of Indian Universities recognized University with at least **45%** marks (**40%** marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) and passed XII standard examination with Mathematics as the subject and with English as the medium of instruction at B.Sc. level.

Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) Maharashtra state generates two separate Merit lists of Inter se Merit for Diploma and B.Sc. students based on their marks obtained at the Final Year or Final Semester / Semesters of Diploma OR B. Sc. Examinations respectively. Based upon the Inter se Merit Number a candidate can seek admission in **Vishwakarma Institute of Technology** through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) rounds as declared by DTE through notifications in leading newspapers and also on its website www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in. and State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra State website (http://cetcell.mahacet.org)

Q.2. What are the eligibility criteria to be fulfilled for securing admission in Engineering/Technology through Second Year Engineering Direct Admission (SEDA) process?

Ans: The eligibility criteria are laid down by DTE, Maharashtra and are published in notifications, brochures and on the website of State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra State website (http://cetcell.mahacet.org). Aplicant has to refer the same.

Q.3. When and how does admission process for Second Year Engineering Direct Admission (SEDA) starts?

Ans: The entire admission process of Maharashtra state is governed by DTE, Maharashtra. Admission notification is regularly flashed in all leading newspapers across and outside Maharashtra and on the website of DTE - www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in. and State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra State website (cetcell.mahacet.org). The entire admission process is online and transparent. Further, the admission process; right from the application form filling to seat allotment is done online. Hence, one has to keep watching State Govt of Maharashtra, DTE Maharashtra, ARA Maharashtra and State CET Cell Maharashtra State website regularly for updates.

Q.4. From where further details will be available?

Ans: For the further details, one should keep screening DTE website and also Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune website. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune also runs admission counseling cell reachable personally and on telephone. 1. Health safety as the Top priority:

Q.7. How does the application process for SEDA works?

Ans:-

- 1. The candidates should apply online on as per schedule and notification about SEDA admission when given on the website http://cetcell.mahacet.org.
- 2. Filling the Online Application Form for admission through their login
- **3.** The candidate should fill the Online Application Form by reading carefully the Information Brochure.
- **4.** After filling the information and submission of Application Form, the Candidates shall verify the data filled and correct it if required. The candidate shall take printout of the form and sign it.
- **5.** This is followed by the confirmation of Online Application Form and Document Verification at Facilitation Centre by the Candidate in person.

- **6.** Display or Publishing of Provisional merit list, Submission of grievances, if any, and Display or Publishing of Final Merit Lists
- 7. Online Submission & Confirmation of Option Form of CAP rounds
- 8. Reporting to the Admission Reporting Centre (ARC) as per Allotment of CAP Round
- **9.** Reporting to the Allotted Institute and Confirmation of Admission by submitting required documents and payment of fee after CAP Round

Q.8. At the time of seat allotment, is the presence of candidate mandatory?

Ans: No. Since entire admission process is online. Seat allotment is also online on merit basis in scheduled counseling rounds. Hence, candidate's presence is not required.

Q.9. Are students from other than Maharashtra state liable to get admission under SEDA in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?

Ans: Yes, through CAP Rounds only.

Q.10. Sir, I have not passed 10th, 12th and Diploma from a recognized institute from Maharashtra state and not born or domiciled in Maharashtra state. However, my father or mother or I is domiciled in Maharashtra state. Can I seek the admission in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune through DTE procedure as a Maharashtra state candidate?

Ans: Yes. However, while filling the online application, please refer the carefully the Information Brochure to choose the appropriate candidate type.

Q.11. Alike other institutes, do Vishwakarma Institute of Technology offer admissions in Institute level seats under SEDA?

Ans: No. At Vishwakarma Institute of Technology there are no institute level seats for SEDA.

Q.12. What are the affiliations of Vishwakarma Institute of Technology for purpose of recognition of degrees?

Ans: Vishwakarma Institute of Technology is an autonomous institute affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly University of Pune). All the undergraduate and post graduate programs are AICTE approved.

Q.13. How quality education is guaranteed in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology?

Ans. Accrediting bodies like National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) and National Board of Accreditation (NBA) both constituted by UGC and MHRD look after and assesses the quality of education delivered by the Institute. Vishwakarma Institute of Technology has received accreditation from both and remains to continue for the same in future.

Q.14. How the assessment is carried out at Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune during the B. Tech. Program?

Ans: At Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune, a Credit Based system with continuous evaluation is followed in semester pattern.

Q.15. What is the cut-off marks required to secure admission in any branch in Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?

Download the CAP round wise CUT offs PDF documents >> then search (Control +F) with typing first word 'Bansilal' to see VIT, Pune (institute code 6273), Cut off Marks. However, note last year cutoff marks are just for reference purpose and are liable to vary based upon the merit list of this year.

Q.16. Are there any seats reserved for foreign nationals for SEDA admissions?

Ans: No. There are no seats reserved for foreign nationals for SEDA admissions.

Q.17. Are hostel facilities available at Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune?

Ans: Yes, Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune provides limited hostel facilities to students based on availability at the time of reporting.

Q.18. Are separate hostel facilities provided to girls?

And: Yes. Girls are provided with separate hostel facilities. Food facility is also available.

Q.19. What is hostel fees?

Ans: Hostel fee is likely to vary from year to year. Hostel charges do not include Mess charges. Hostel fees as well as Mess charges are collected for complete academic year. Q.20. Is internet facility available at hostel?

Ans: YES. Internet facility is available on chargeable basis. Internet charges will be known at the time of hostel admission.
