

First year BTech Online MCQ-Mid Semester Examinations

Dear Student,

2024-25 Semester-II, Mid semester MCQ examination for First year B.Tech students is scheduled on 22, 23 and 24 April 2025.

The following are the instructions for MCQ-MSE:

- A) This exam is proctored (Manual proctored as well as AI enabled proctored, any malpractice may lead to punitive action.)
- B) Students will give this proctored exam from Home therefore they must ensure charging of laptops. (In case of electricity failure at student end).
- C) Students must ensure availability of internet enabled Laptop. It is compulsory to give an exam using a laptop computer, no other device is permitted.
- D) Students must give the exam as per given schedule as no re-examination will be scheduled if any student will miss the exam.
- E) Students must keep the camera compulsorily ON during exams. If the video is off, the exam will be paused by the proctor.
- F) It is compulsory for students to join google meet/Zoom meeting, link will be shared by individual subject teacher (proctor).
- G) Tab switching during exam will lead to termination of exam immediately.
- H) Please note subject wise instructions as follows -
 - For HS1071: Linear Algebra and Differential Equations and
 - HS1076: Calculus And Statistics
 - o Every student will get 20 questions per subject. (Every student will get randomly selected questions from the subject's question bank; answer options will be shuffled for each student). Each question is of 3 marks
 - o Exam duration for each subject is 1 hour.
 - o <u>First 20 minutes to join and to give attendance and remaining 40 minutes MCQ exam on</u> <u>software.</u>
 - For HS1073: Indian Knowledge System,
 - HS1077: Universal Human Values,
 - AI1020, CI1019, ML1020: Computer Organization and Architecture,
 - ME1019: Mechanical Systems Engineering and
 - CV1019: Engineering Mechanics
 - Every student will get 30 questions per subject. (Every student will get randomly selected questions from the subject's question bank; answer options will be shuffled for each student). Each question is of 2 marks.
 - o Exam duration for each subject is 1 hour and 15 minutes.,
 - First 15 minutes to join and to give attendance and remaining 60 minutes MCQ exam on software.



• For ET1019: Electronic Circuits

- o Every student will get 15 questions in this subject. (Every student will get randomly selected questions from the subject's question bank; answer options will be shuffled for each student). Each question is of 4 marks.
- o Exam duration for each subject is 1 hour and 15 minutes.
- o First 15 minutes to join and to give attendance and remaining 60 minutes MCQ exam on software.

I) In case of any malpractice, students will get punishment as per institute policy.

You can ask your queries to subject teachers. In case of any issue during the exam, contact the subject teacher only. (Exam will be conducted, monitored and proctored by subject teacher only)

Dummy exams will be conducted. The schedule will be communicated later through separate mail. Please note that the dummy exam will have some general questions which are not from any FY subject. This exam is just taken to give you exposure to MCQ software. So, this is not a practice exam.
